



Job Description: Scenic Painter

The following statements are intended to describe the general nature and level of work being performed. They are not intended to be construed as an exhaustive list of all responsibilities, duties, and skills required of personnel so classified.

The Scenic Painter is responsible for the successful completion of the painting phase of production to meet both budgetary and scheduling goals. This is a hands-on position that will report directly to the Paint Shop Foreman.

Key Responsibilities:

- Prep, texture, paint scenic elements from renders and verbal instruction
- Understand scenic painting techniques, layout and paint application skills, and color mixing
- Interpret designers small-scale ideas and develop them into full-scale reproductions
- Assist with inventory and maintenance of sprayers and equipment
- Assure that a clean and safe work environment is maintained

Qualifications:

- Minimum BA or BFA technical production degree or experience
- Minimum 1 year of solid industry experience in technical theater and/or scenic fabrication
- Solid understanding in the fine art skills of sketching, rendering, and painting
- Must have a team oriented, collaborative work ethic
- Ability to communicate ideas clearly
- Must have outstanding relationship skills and have a team-oriented, collaborative work ethic
- Ability to work overtime

- Required repetitive use of feet and hands.
- Ability to stand for duration of shift
